Oriole Avenue	Confirmed mixed outbreak of COVID and Corona virus.
New on Jan 13th: Bluebird Terrace	Bluebird has now been placed in a confirmed Coronavirus (NOT COVID) Respiratory outbreak.

With the increase in the number of residents symptomatic, the decision has been made to implement home wide masking for everyone entering the facility.

Please continue with proper hand hygiene, wearing of your mask properly at all times, social distancing, and continue with your personal self-screening.

We will continue to monitor each outbreak and hopefully we can see a decrease in the number of residents affected. Masking will be reassessed as outbreaks clear.

All staff are encouraged to get a flu shot. If you haven't already received yours, please contact Katrina Marques to make arrangements, or visit a pharmacy to get your shot (remember to submit your slip to IPAC staff indicating you have received it). You must have received a flu shot in order to work in a home area where there is an active flu outbreak. Staff may be moved or taken out of the work schedule without pay if you are working in a home area that goes into a flu outbreak and you haven't received the shot.

Any resident under isolation precautions should be in their rooms. If they are unable to stay in their room, they should be encouraged to wear a mask when they are in the hallway or common areas on the unit. The resident under isolation precautions should NOT be in the dining room for meals. If they are not able to stay in their room, they should be seated at the entrance of the dining room – across from the medication room and be alone at the table.
